

## **TRANSPORTATION BIBS – ERRATA** June 29, 2014

The numbers in the left strap and shaping for the boat bib were off by 1. The corrections are in bold below. Also, instructions for making an I cord were added to page 1.

### Left side shaping and strap

- Row 2 ws: s1kw, k1, p1, k1, p1, p2tog, **p7**
- Row 3 rs: s1kw, k2tog, **k5**, work 5 edge stitches
- Row 4 ws: s1kw, k1, p1, k1, p1, p2tog, **p5**
- Row 5 rs: s1kw, k2tog, **k3**, work 5 edge stitches
- Row 6 ws: s1kw, k1, p1, k1, p1, p2tog, **p3**
- Row 7 rs: s1kw, k2tog, **k1**, work 5 edge stitches
- Row 8 ws: s1kw, k1, p1, k1, p1, p2tog, **p1**
- Row 9 rs: s1kw, k2tog, **k1**, p1, k1, p1
- Row 10 ws: s1kw, k1, p1, **k1**, p2tog
- Row 11 rs: s1kw, k2tog, k1, **p1**
- **Row 12 ws: slkw, k1, p2tog**

Work the 3 remaining 3 stitches to 11" I cord

### I cord: - all stitches worked on right side

- On a dp needle, knit 3 stitches
- Do not turn work
- Slip the 3 stitches to the other end of the dp needle
- The working yarn will be on the left end of the needle
- Pull the yarn behind the 3 stitches, and knit the 3 stitches again.
- Repeat to the desired length.
